READING: Through reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts, we will be learning how to infer information from the books we read and how to use evidence from the book to support our ideas. We will be looking closely at new vocabulary and using this in our writing. We will continue to develop our fluency and interest in new texts. Please continue to hear your child read everyday at home - it really supports their progress. It is particularly important to talk about the book and ask simple questions.

<u>MATHS</u>: We will be following the national curriculum in Maths appropriate for each child's ability level. We will we exploring numbers to 20, learning number bonds to 5 and then 10, making comparison of quantities and learning to recognise, compose, decompose and manipulate 2D and 3D shapes. We will continue to use Mathletics at home to support our learning.

ENGLISH: In English this term we will be using talking partners to share our thoughts and opinions. This will help with our listening and speaking skills. We will use a range of stories including: Ruby's Worry, Superworm and Super Daisy. Throughout all of our lessons, we will be working on our handwriting, spelling and punctuation skills.

<u>MAINSTREAM</u> Year 1 and 2 children access Topic, Science, PE, Music, Art, RE and PHSE in their mainstream classes – please see the mainstream newsletters for any information.
