PHONICS: We will continue with our phonics scheme Sounds Write this year. If you would like to support your child at home or would like any more information, there are parent videos available online at <https://www.sounds-write.co.uk/>. You can also sign up for the free parent course (link available on the website) if you would like. If you have further questions please ask in the home/school diary.

READING: Through reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts, we will be learning how to infer information from the text and the pictures. We will be looking closely at new vocabulary and learning the meaning of these words. Please continue to hear your child read everyday at home - it really supports their progress. It is particularly important to talk about the book and ask simple questions.

MATHS: We will be following the national curriculum in Maths appropriate for each child's ability level. We will be exploring numbers to 20, learning number bonds to 5 and then 10, making comparison of quantities and learning to recognise, compose, decompose and manipulate 2D and 3D shapes. We will continue to use Mathematics at home to support our learning.

ENGLISH: In English this term we will be using talking partners to share our thoughts and opinions. This will help with our listening and speaking skills. We will use a range of stories with the children. Throughout all of our lessons, we will be working on our handwriting, spelling and punctuation skills.
